Would you like an opportunity to gain an employee who will be given additional school support and guidance while working for you?

If yes, then the Cooperative Work Experience (COOP) program may be for you.

COOP is a school-sponsored program in collaboration with Vocational Rehabilitation designed for an individual student to gain paid employment as part of the school course of study.

- Students are released from school for part of the day
- Students earn elective credit towards graduation for their work
- Internships may be considered
- Students are assigned a Work Experience Coordinator from the school who will coordinate and provide off-campus supervision

- Improving consistency in work attendance/reliability by providing an avenue for students to earn high school credit while working
- If you are a federal contractor, potentially meeting hiring goals through offering job opportunities for people with disabilities
